Beneficiaries of the Anne Stafford Light up the Future Bursary will have an enhanced social role as a result of their pursuit of a personal development opportunity.

Background and Purpose:

Anne worked for Community Living Ontario for almost 30 years, helping our movement in many ways, including the pursuit of alternatives to institutionalization. The Light up the Future Bursary was started in 1993 in honour of Anne's retirement, in hopes of leaving a legacy that would support people who have an intellectual disability to pursue personal development opportunities.

The bursary has been supported by fundraising efforts at Community Living Ontario, fundraising, and the generous donations of many member organizations.

Criteria:

The bursary is open to Ontario residents aged 18 and older who have been identified as having an intellectual disability and are seeking to pursue a professional development opportunity through an educational program or personal interest course.

Applications will be accepted up to **4:00 pm on Friday, July 13, 2018.**

Should your application be selected and you do not attend the course, you agree to return the money within one (1) month from the day you received the money. If you cannot complete the course, you agree to notify Community Living Ontario within one (1) month.
