

JAMES MONTGOMERIE COMMUNITY AWARD

An award for an organization that demonstrates leadership and innovation in furthering the goals and vision of Community Living.

Deadline for nominations is Friday, June 28, 2019

The James Montgomerie Community Award was established in memory of Jim Montgomerie, an educator and past president of Community Living Ontario. The award was established based on Jim's belief that people who have an intellectual disability and who live in institutions, homes for special care, and nursing homes deserve a better quality of life. He dedicated much of his time and energy to this belief.

In March 2009, the doors of the remaining three large institutions closed, but our work is still not complete. There are still many people living in institutional settings.

2018 Recipients

In 2018, the James Montgomerie Award was given to Community Living Mississauga and accepted by Lisa Kitchener and Jamie Curran on behalf of the organization.

Who is eligible?

This award is presented to an organization that actively addresses the legacy of institutions in our society and moves toward practices that focus on inclusion and individual autonomy.

It is based People First of Canada's definition of an institution:

An institution is any place in which people who have been labeled as having an intellectual disability are isolated, segregated and/or congregated. An institution is any place in which people do not have, or are not allowed to exercise, control over their lives and their day-to-day decisions. An institution is not defined merely by its size.

How are recipients chosen?

Recipients are chosen by a selection panel made up of members of the Community Living Ontario Awards Committee.
